Trader Terms and Conditions

To Secure Your Trading Pitch:

All bookings must be confirmed before completing the booking form. Please ensure that you read these terms and conditions and complete all sections of the online booking form, including that you have Public Liability Insurance and payment is made to confirm your booking.

Trader Pitch Sizes:

- The standard size for a covered internal pitch within one of the Cressing Temple barns is 3 metre frontage and 3 metre depth.
- External uncovered pitch sizes are located on one of the grassed areas outside of the barns.

Booking Fee & Payment

The booking fee is £30.00 per pitch (3m x 3m)

To confirm your booking payment is required at the time of completing the online booking form.

Booking Terms and Conditions

- 1 The organisers reserve the right to refuse bookings without giving a reason.
- 2 Bookings will be accepted on receipt of bank transfer payment for the booking fee.
- 3 Traders will be admitted to the site from 7.30am on the Sunday morning, please do not arrive before this time.
- 4 Stalls must be in place by 9.30 am and not broken down until after 4 pm.
- 5 Traders must site any vehicle necessary for their trade within their designated external pitch. All other vehicles must be moved away from the public area by 9.30 am and remain there until 4 pm.
- 6 Traders are responsible for leaving their designated area as they found them and clear of litter.
- 7 Traders must produce on request a Public Liability Certificate (Minimum cover £1million)
- 8 Traders selling food must produce on request their food business registration, FHRS score and evidence of food handling certificates Level 2.
- 9 Alcohol sellers will not require a Temporary Event Notice as Cressing Temple will have one that covers all traders.
- 10 Traders will keep the organiser indemnified in respect of any loss or damage caused by themselves or their helpers to the organisers or third parties. Traders will accept all risks of every kind whether to persons or property or make good or pay for any damage.
- 11 Traders should have adequate insurance against all risks including bad weather cancellation. If in the opinion of Friends of Cressing Temple it is necessary to cancel an event because of prevailing weather conditions or any other reason there will be no refund of fees.
- 12 For external pitches Traders will be provided with a pitch only and the trader is responsible for providing tables, gazebos etc. For internal pitches within the barns Traders will be provided with a 6 foot table and two chairs.
- 13 Trading spaces cannot be sub-let.
- 14 Notwithstanding any of these terms and conditions, the Trader will in every respect comply with all relevant regulations issued by the local authority, the fire authority and the police.
- 15 Pitches will be allocated by the organisers prior to the event.
- 16 Should the event need to be cancelled the booking fee will be refunded.

Trader Declaration:

- I accept that in a dispute the Organisers decision is final.
